The Yukon Freestyle Ski head coach function provides high level coaching to YFSA competitive athletes while overseeing Club program operations. This technical leadership role requires the understanding of the various development needs and stages of athletes and coaches through the Freestyle Canada's (LTAD) models. The YFSA head coach is responsible for program development & implementation, athlete training plan's, season scheduling, budgeting, coach recruitment and supervision.

Roles and Responsibilities

- ▶ Act as an ambassador for the Yukon Freestyle Ski Team
- ▶ Provide high level technical coaching to YFSA athletes
- ▶ Oversee club coaches and provide support through leadership and training
- ▶ Develop YFSA on-snow, trampoline & airbag training programs
- ▶ Communicate program details and schedules to parents, athletes, coaches & board
- ▶ Attend and coach at competitions
- ▶ Attend and participate in YFSA meetings, functions and events
- ▶ Report equipment inventory and facility requirements
- ▶ Assist in the maintenance of YFSA facilities
- ▶ Plan, track and evaluate training athletes and programs
- ▶ Responsible for planning & periodization of airbag, water ramp, and on-snow coaching; thus, ensuring mastered fundamentals, progression, and style
- ▶ Prepare annual, weekly, daily training plans on an individual basis and help athletes tactically with competition runs ensuring alignment of the overall quadrennial and annual plans
- ▶ Track and monitor the progression of athletes
- ▶ Develop reports to the athletes with feedback on progress and suggestions for improvement
- ▶ Communicate professionally and courteously with athletes parents
- ▶ Enforce team "rules" and expectations
