INVITATION

Freestyle Panorama Ski Club (FPSC) and Freestyle Canada (FC) are pleased to invite you to attend the Western Canadian Cup Series, **January 11-14, 2024**. This Canadian open is part of the Canada Cup Series Canada Cup Rankings: <https://freestylecanada.ski/policies/event-policies/>

RULES:

1. The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Freestyle Panorama (FPSC) in partnership with Panorama Mountain Resort (PMR) and Freestyle Canada (FC).
2. Rules are based on Freestyle Canada Cup Guidelines for Canada Cup events.
3. The Competition is comprised of one Mogul and one Dual Mogul event.
4. All athletes must have a minimum Can Freestyle certified Air 4 Coach present with Aerial Passports readily available to present to the Event Jury.
5. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers.
6. The Competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Official Program.

FORMAT OF EVENT:

SINGLE:

- 2 Qualification runs, best of 2 advances to final
- Q2: Same run order
- FINALS: Max of 16 athletes total for finals (Gender split determined at TCM based on gender ratio)

DUALS:

- QUALIFICATION: Single run
- FINALS: Up to top 32 seeded from qualification

*Formats and Finals field size can be adjusted by the jury in consultation with Freestyle Canada

The Competition Office will be located in the Copper Crown Reception Room (Figure 1). Athletes need to check in prior to training to pick up bibs and confirm registration information. The office will be open for registration and payment:

- Wednesday evening: 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm
- Thursday/Friday/Saturday/Sunday: 7:00 am - 6:00 pm

Spectator Access

The Rollercoaster venue is only accessible by skiers. Spectators will need to purchase a lift pass from Guest Services.



REGISTRATION

The Panorama Mountain Resort Canada Cup follows the Priority registration policy for PSO teams and HPAD athletes as described in the Freestyle Canada Cup guidelines.

- OPEN Registration Entries to be received by January 4th, 2024, 8:00 MST.
- \$260 + SnowReg processing fees per participant
- Participants must register on-line individually. Payments are made online.

Refund Policy:

Once an athlete is confirmed on a start list, refunds will not be issued. In the case of an injury, the coach must notify the registration desk to inform that an athlete is injured and unable to ski before the Team Captains meeting the day before competition day. In this case, athletes are entitled to partial refunds of up to 50% per event. Requests for refunds for other extraordinary circumstances shall be considered only at the discretion of the Organizing Committee. If an event is canceled due to weather or exceptional circumstances no refunds will be provided. (The organizing committee has already incurred all costs for the event). REGISTRATION (con't)

Bibs:

- Bibs can be picked up during Competition Office hours: \$20 cash deposit is required.
- Must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.
- Volunteers will collect the bibs at the bottom of the course and return the deposit during the Dual Moguls competition.
- It is important that your bib number match your event registration for judging and scoring. If you need to replace your bib, please ensure your coach updates the on-site race office.

Lift Tickets:

Panorama Mountain Resort is pleased to offer discounted lift passes to all competitors at a rate of 25% off of the window price (note: rates do not include taxes or the \$5 RFID refundable card deposit). Competition day lift tickets are available at Guest Services in the Ski Tip Lodge. To obtain your competitor lift passes, please present your race bib to the ticket office at Guest Services.

All competitors, staff and on-hill volunteers must carry an RFID electronic lift ticket and complete a PMR waiver prior to accessing the mountain or chairlifts. Volunteers receiving a complimentary lift pass from the Competition Office will be required to complete the waiver on-line.

***Complimentary coaches' passes** will be available at a rate of 2 per 8 athletes. They will be available for pickup at the Race Office.



Aerial Qualifications

All athletes must have up-to-date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The FC Technical Delegate will verify a random selection of athlete's qualifications during the Team Leaders meeting the day before each event with the **coach** of the athlete. Verification of qualification will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- Signed Aerial Passports held by coach/athlete
- Completed and signed qualification forms
- FC qualification databank

AWARDS CEREMONY

Top finishers will be awarded at the end of each day of competition. Please refer to the schedule for timing and location.

ACCOMMODATION

PMR will provide a discount on lodging rates for event participants. LIABILITY AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE

All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the manoeuvres being performed in training and competition. All athletes, coaches and officials must have a valid FC membership. The organizing committee, the PSO, the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, the resort and the Canadian Snowsports Association shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second- or third-party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are urged to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.

LICENSES

- Athletes are required to have a valid FC license (provincial or FIS athlete license).
- Coaches are required to have a valid FC license and all of the requirements related to its validation (background check, appropriate training, mandatory NCCP modules)
- Officials and volunteers are required to have a valid FC license

RESORT RULES

- The Alpine Code of Responsibility must be followed by all athletes, coaches, officials, spectators and volunteers.
- There is no lift line priority for athletes. Please respect the lift line rules and adhere to any instructions from resort staff.
- Helmets are mandatory for all athletes, coaches, officials and volunteers involved in the event when moving on snow.

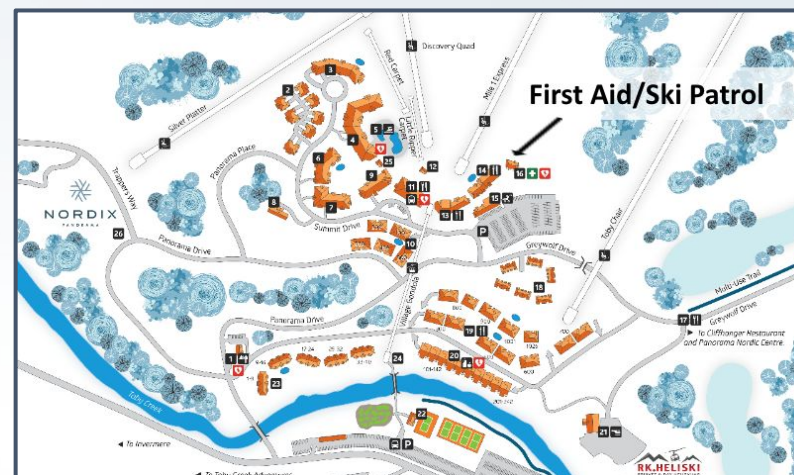
