RULES

1. The event is sanctioned by FC and is organized by Freestyle Ontario in collaboration with Horseshoe Resort.
2. Rules are based on a combination of FIS Rules and Regulations and Freestyle Canada, Canada Cup Competition Guidelines.
3. The Competition is comprised of two (2) Events (Slopestyle and Big Air)
4. All athletes must have a FC licenced coach present with sufficient qualifications for their intended manoeuvres and a Provincial Athlete Licence.
5. Athlete Air Qualification is required for all inverted and off-axis maneuvers with documentation readily available to present to the Event Jury.

FIELD SIZE, REGISTRATION, AND ELIGIBILITY

FIELD SIZE - The field size is limited to 85 athletes.

Female: 50% of allocated sports.

Male: 50% of allocated spots.

Unused spots may be transferred between genders. (5 Spots for host PSO's)

REGISTRATION – Event Registration is open until February 21st, 2024, or until registration is full (85 athletes). Registration for Big Air and Slopestyle will be \$260 + HST + SnowReg Service Fee. Canadian athletes must have a Provincial Athlete License.

ELIGIBILITY

Athletes must be approved by PSO's to meet Freestyle Canada quotas. There are no age categories

- Priority Registration clause for HPAD Teams (PSO & NextGen)
- Foreign athletes must be approved by Freestyle Canada and their NSO

REFUND POLICY

At any point if a participant provides a doctor's note stating they are unable to attend the event after registering, a full refund will be provided minus the 5% SnowReg fee. A full refund will be provided, minus the 5% SnowReg fee prior to Sunday, February 14th for any reason.

If after February 14th a refund is required for a non-medical reason, only 50% of the fee will be refunded. If the event is cancelled due to Covid-19 or a related issue, FO will work to reasonably recoup losses where possible and refund any revenue generated consistent with our practices and policies. There is no guarantee of a refund of any amount in the event of a Covid-19 related cancellation.

Once an athlete is confirmed on a start list, no refund will be issues to that participant for the duration of the competition. If an event is cancelled due to weather on the day of the event, no refund will be provided.





EVENT FORMAT

QUALIFICATION SLOPESTYLE: Best of 2 runs, heats of 20 - 30. Use up to date HPP rankings to evenly distribute top HPP ranked athletes in attendance. If no HPP resource available use rankings as of Sept 1.

QUALIFICATION BIG AIR: Best of 2 runs, heats of 20 - 30. Use up to date HPP rankings to evenly distribute top HPP ranked athletes in attendance. If no HPP resource available use rankings as of Sept 1.

FINAL SLOPESTYLE: Men & Women: Top 40% of Qualification field move to final with a minimum of 4 and maximum of 20 athletes, # of heats and # of athletes to be decided at the first Team Captains meeting - dependent on registration & final field sizes. (Best of 2 runs)

FINAL BIG AIR: Top 40% of Qualification field move to final with a minimum of 4 and maximum of 20 athletes, # of heats and # of athletes to be decided at the first Team Captains meeting - dependent on registration & final field sizes.

COMPETITION OFFICE, BIBS, AND LIFT TICKETS

OFFICE - The competition office is located in the fairway room inside the main chalet at Horseshoe Resort. Follow signs for the Canada Cup Registration office. **COACHES** must check-in their athletes at the competition office to confirm participation in the event and pick-up bibs.





BIBS - \$20.00 cash bib deposit is required. Bibs must be returned at the bottom of the course or to the competition office in good condition. If a bib is lost or forgotten, there will be an additional \$20 deposit. It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring, if you need to replace your bib please ensure the onsite registration staff updates your entry information. Bibs must be worn properly for all onsite training, for competitions and awards ceremonies.

LIFT TICKETS - Competition lift tickets can be purchased online using the link below for a cost of \$55.00 + hst per day. Tickets are valid from open to close. Officials and coaches lift tickets will be complimentary with a maximum of two per team. Please select the four day option from the drop down menu at the top of the page.

There are no refunds. To qualify for this competition pricing, athletes must buy their lift ticket online or present their bib at Guest Services. Each competitor must have a valid lift ticket and bib to access the venues for each day of the event. Lift tickets / passes are non-transferable.

SPECTATOR ACCESS

Spectator access will be limited to the corral at the base of the course. The corral is located at the bottom of steeplechase, a short walk from the main lodge.

Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the manoeuvres being performed in training and competition and is also available through Freestyle Canada when you register for your membership. The Organizing Committee, Freestyle Ontario, Horseshoe Resort, and the Canadian Snowsports Association shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second or third-party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are urged to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.
