GENERAL

The APEX CLASSIC will take place as follows:

- Thursday, December 14, 2023 Unofficial Training
- Friday, December 15, 2023 Official Training
- Saturday, December 16, 2023 SINGLE MOGULS*
- Sunday, December 17, 2023 DUAL MOGULS*

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to change the schedule.

QUOTA:

- Field Size: 110
- Maximum of 80 Canadians spots
- National team program athletes have priority.
- Maximum of 30 foreign spots (15 per gender)
- Priority of quota allocation:
- 1. National team athletes
- 2. Following Top 20 per gender from 2022/23 final HPP Rankings
- 3. 6 spots per province, Ideally equal gender split
- 4. Unused PSO spots will be redistributed to other PSOs requesting more spots. If there is more demand than spots available, the 2022-23 Athlete membership numbers in the categories U14, U16, U18 and U20, by PSO, will be factored to determine the distribution of remaining spots.
- 5. Unused female spots can be made available to extra male athletes with FC approval
- 6. Unused Canadian spots will go to Foreign athletes
- PROVINCES DO NOT HAVE TO FILL THEIR QUOTA if they feel their athletes are not ready.









ELIGIBILITY:

- FIS age/license required: 14 years old before December 2023 (see ICR 2014.8) for the FIS event.
- National team athletes
- Guiding principle: Athletes should be top 1/3rd of their Provincial events AND able to compete one 360 and/or invert in a Canada Cup level course.
- Foreign athletes need to be registered by their National Ski Association and approved by Freestyle Canada.

All registration closes December 1, 2023

- 1. By November 1st National Team program athletes and HPP top 20 athletes are confirmed.
- 2. By November 4th PSOs request desired extra spots, including list of athletes by name, by emailing julien@freestylecanada.ski.com
- 3. By November 5th Freestyle Canada confirms the number of spots per PSO.
- 4. By November 10th Freestyle Canada offers any remaining spots to PSO requesting additional quotas.
- 5. All registered athletes must have an active FIS license by December 5th

Foreign athletes will be confirmed by Freestyle Canada by December 2nd to ensure Canadian participation to fill extra quotas.

Coaches will receive athlete bibs at time of check in and after completion of waivers and bios.

SCORING

- Freestyle Solution Lite (formerly called World Cup Lite) scoring program will be used.
- Live scoring link will be distributed when available.

ENTRY FEES

PER PARTICIPANT is \$260.00 for two days of competition.

LICENSES

- Athletes are required to have a valid FC license (FIS athlete license with an active FIS number).
- Coaches that represent a Canadian team are required to have a valid FC license and all requirements related to its validation (background check, appropriate training, mandatory NCCP modules)
- Officials and volunteers are required to have a valid FC license

<u>REFUNDS</u>

Once an athlete is confirmed on the start list, refunds will not be issued. In the case of an injury the coach or parent must notify the registration desk to inform the Event Registrar that the athlete is injured and unable to ski. This









must occur before the Team Captain's meeting the day before the competition.

Athletes are entitled to partial refunds of up to 50% per event. Requests for refunds for other extraordinary circumstances shall be considered only at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.

If an event is canceled due to weather or exceptional circumstances no refunds will be provided as The Organizing Committee would be obligated to pay for all costs for the event. Please see the Canada Freestyle Competition Guide for Rules and Procedures regarding refunds.

LIABILITY AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE

All athletes, officials and other members who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the maneuvers being performed in training and competition. All athletes, coaches and officials must have a valid FC membership. The organizing committee, the PSO, the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, the resort and the Canadian Snowsports Association shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second- or third-party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are urged to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.

LIFT TICKETS

- Lift tickets will be available for purchase each day of training and competition at the ticket booth with presentation of competitor bib.
- Each competitor is responsible for the purchase of his or her own lift ticket for each day of the event.
- Apex Mountain Resort offers reduced ticket prices to athletes. Athletes will receive a 25% discount for lift pass (discount applies to single day passes only, multi-day passes not included) or the respective reciprocal season pass discounts to their home mountain (you will need to show your home mountain season pass)
- Athletes must purchase tickets at resort ticket booth.

- Ticket office opens at 8 am daily
- Complimentary lift tickets for coaching staff, judges, media, officials and volunteers are available at the Competition Office each day, but are limited in numbers.
