# INVITATION

Freestyle Yukon and Freestyle Canada (FC) are pleased to invite you to attend the Yukon Canada Cup, **December 4-8, 2024**. This event is part of the Canada Cup Series and of the Canada Cup Rankings:

## RULES

1. The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and organized by Freestyle Yukon in partnership with Mount Sima and Freestyle Canada (FC).
2. Rules are based on Freestyle Canada Cup Guidelines.
3. The Competition is comprised of one Slopestyle and one Big Air event.
4. All athletes must have a minimum Freestyle Canada certified Air 4 Coach present.
5. Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers, random verification will be made.
6. The Competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Official Program.

## FORMAT OF EVENT

- Qualifications Slopestyle/Big Air
  - Best of 2 runs/jumps
  - Heats of 20 - 30\*
  - Use Final 23-24 HPP ranking to evenly distribute top ranked athletes in attendance.
- \*Heats may go to 35 if approved by FC director of events and Head Judge
- FINAL Slopestyle/Big Air: Men & Women:
  - Top 40% of Qualification results move to Finals, composed of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 20 athletes.
  - Best of 2 runs for Slopestyle
  - Best 2 of 3 jumps, with 2 different direction jumps counting for final rankings for Big Air.
  - # of heats and # of athletes to be decided at the first Team Captains meeting - dependent on registration & final field sizes.

## REGISTRATION

The Yukon Canada Cup follows the Canada Cup guidelines for all rules and spot distribution.

- \$300 + SnowReg processing fees per participant

### **Refund Policy:**

Once an athlete is confirmed on a start list, refunds will not be issued. In the case of an injury, the coach must notify the registration desk to inform that an athlete is injured and unable to ski before the Team Captains meeting the day before competition day. In this case, athletes are entitled to partial refunds of up to 50% per event. Requests for refunds for other extraordinary circumstances shall be considered only at the discretion of the Organizing Committee. If an event is canceled due to weather or exceptional circumstances no refunds will be provided. (The organizing committee has already incurred all costs for the event).



## Bibs

- Bibs can be picked up during Competition Office hours.
- Must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.
- No deposit is required, but Teams will be held responsible if not returned (and charged if applicable).
- Volunteers will collect the bibs at the bottom of the course after SS qualifications and finals.
- It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring.

## Lift Tickets

Lift tickets will be available for purchase each day of 'official' training and competition at Guest Services with the presentation of the competitor bib. The cost of a lift ticket will be \$70.00+ GST for the full day. No half day tickets are available. Each competitor is responsible for the purchase of his or her own lift ticket for each day of the event.

- OC will provide free lift tickets for coaches.
- Up to 1 ticket per 4 athletes register under the same team
- Coach license required
- Registration required

**Payment for lift tickets can be made in person at Mount Sima or in advance through Mount Sima Pre-season.**



## AERIAL QUALIFICATIONS

All athletes must have up-to-date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The FC Technical Delegate will verify a random selection of athlete's qualifications during the Team Leaders meeting the day before each event with the **coach** of the athlete. Verification of qualification will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- Signed Aerial Passports held by coach/athlete
- Completed and signed qualification forms
- FC qualification databank

Top finishers will be awarded at the end of each final. Please refer to the schedule for timing and location.

### **LICENSES**

- Coaches are required to have a valid FC license and all of the requirements related to its validation (background check, appropriate training, mandatory NCCP modules)

\*Big Air and Banked Slalom are bookable for private sessions all season after preseason ends on Dec 5th.

We open for the public on Dec 6th, but your teams are more than welcome to continue training in the parks.

### 02 Rates

**Full Day Session: \$126 (Inclusive of Lunch) / \$115 (Without Lunch)**

- Prices are in CDN dollars, per participant plus GST (5%) and includes athlete hill access and unlimited complimentary coach lift tickets.
- Facility access tickets for guests and/or individual staff or other personnel are \$59 per day and include chairlift access
- Bookings are confirmed upon receipt of a 10% deposit.
- In the event early season training is not available due to environmental factors, teams will receive a full refund less 10% deposit
