


RULES

- 1. The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada (FC) and organized by the Freestyle Panorama Ski Club (FPSC) in partnership with Panorama Mountain Resort (PMR) and Freestyle Canada.
- 2. Rules are based on Freestyle Canada Cup Guidelines.
- 3. The Competition is comprised of one Single Mogul and one Dual Mogul event.
- **4.** All athletes must have a minimum Freestyle Canada certified Air 4 Coach present.
- **5.** Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers, random verification will be made.
- **6.** The Competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Official Program*.
 - * No Repeats for same jump categories (ex: can't do a back tuck and a back flip mute grab. Can't do 7op & 7oG. Can't do a 360 and a 360 with a grab). Same category jumps are allowed with additional rotations or more difference (ex: 360 & 720, or 7o & 10o)

FORMAT OF EVENT

Single:

- 2 Qualification runs, best of 2 runs advances to final.
- Q2: Same run order.
- FINALS: 16 athletes total for Finals: 8 women and 8 men

Duals:

Duals from the start : seeding according to results from singles
 Ski lane will be attributed randomly (follow brackets)


GENERAL INFORMATION

The Competition Office will be located in the Copper Crown Reception Room (Figure 1). Athletes need to check in prior to training to pick up bibs and confirm registration information. The office will be open for registration and payment:

- Wednesday evening: 6:00 pm 8:00 pm
- Thursday/Friday/Saturday/Sunday: 7:00 am 5:00 pm



Spectator Access:

The Rollercoaster venue is only accessible by skiers. Spectators will need to purchase a lift pass from Guest Services.



REGISTRATION

This event follows the Canada Cup guidelines for all rules and spot distribution:

- \$280 + SnowReg processing fees per participant.
- Participants must register on-line individually. Payments are made online.

Refund Policy:

Once an athlete is confirmed on a start list, refunds will not be issued. In the case of an injury, the coach must notify the registration desk to inform that an athlete is injured and unable to ski before the Team Captains' meeting the day before competition day. In this case, athletes are entitled to partial refunds of up to 50% per event. Requests for refunds for other extraordinary circumstances shall be considered only at the discretion of the Organizing Committee. If an event is canceled due to weather or exceptional circumstances no refunds will be provided. (The organizing committee has already incurred all costs for the event).



- Bibs can be picked up during Competition Office hours.
- Must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.
- No deposit is required, but Teams will be held responsible if not returned (and charged if applicable).
- Volunteers will collect the bibs at the bottom of the course after Dual Mogul Competition.
- It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring.





Lift Tickets:

Panorama Mountain Resort is pleased to offer discounted lift passes to all competitors at a rate of 25% off of the window price (note: rates do not include taxes or the \$5 RFID refundable card deposit). To obtain your competitor lift passes, please present your race bib to the ticket office at Guest Services in the Ski Tip Lodge.

All competitors, staff and on-hill volunteers must carry an RFID electronic lift ticket and complete a PMR waiver prior to accessing the mountain or chairlifts. Volunteers receiving a complimentary lift pass from the Competition Office will be required to complete an online waiver.

- OC will provide complimentary lift tickets for coaches on a 1 ticket per 4 athlete basis.
- Teams with less than 4 athletes will receive 1 complimentary coach ticket.

AERIAL QUALIFICATIONS

All athletes must have up-to-date aerial qualifications for jumps they are performing in all disciplines. The FC Technical Delegate will verify a random selection of athlete's qualifications during the Team Leaders meeting the day before each event with the **coach** of the athlete. Verification of qualification will be accepted from any of the following sources:

- Completed and signed qualification forms
- FC qualification databank





AWARDS CEREMONY

Top finishers will be awarded at the end of each final. Please refer to the schedule for timing and location.

LIABILITY AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE

All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the manoeuvres being performed in training and competition. All athletes, coaches, officials and volunteers must have a valid FC membership. The organizing committee, the P/TSO, Freestyle Canada and the resort shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second- or third-party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are urged to protect and safeguard their personal belongings at all times.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Please note that there will be **ZERO TOLERANCE** for any offensive language or behaviour during the event. Any damages or disruption to hotel, facilities or other property related to this event will result in the offender(s) being immediately removed from the event.

LICENSES

- Athletes are required to have a valid FC license (provincial or FIS athlete license).
- Coaches are required to have a valid FC license and all of the requirements related to its validation (background check, appropriate training, mandatory NCCP modules).
- Officials and volunteers are required to have a valid FC license.



- There is no lift line priority for athletes. Please respect the lift line rules and adhere to any instructions from resort staff.
- Helmets are mandatory for all athletes, coaches, officials and volunteers involved in the event when moving on snow.
